RECREATION

Key activity highlights include:

BAY LOBSTER FESTIVAL

The Authentic Seacoast™ Resorts celebrate lobster season on Chedabucto Bay with a Nova Scotia Lobster Festival in May & June. This two month lobster festival includes lobster cooking classes, guided trips to the fishing wharf to meet the lobster boat and lots of great lobster dinners.

HARBOURFRONT CEILIDH PARTIES

Wednesday evenings on the Guysborough waterfront are Ceilidh Party night where local musicians celebrate the Celtic music heritage of Nova Scotia with some toe tapping music.

BONFIRES AT MUSSEL COVE

The bonfire pit at Osprey Shores Golf Resort is a great place to share stories about the authentic seacoast with both locals and from aways.

GOLF

SPORTS

There is an extensive range of sporting activities on-site at Osprey Shores Resort including swimming in the outdoor pool, volleyball, badminton, croquet, golf and horseshoes. DINING
